BY THE COMMISSION: On June 29, 2016, Tomlin Mill Solar, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 5-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar generating facility to be located approximately 4,200 feet east of the intersection of Tomlin Mill Road and Interstate 77, Statesville, Iredell County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC).

Contemporaneously with the application, the Applicant filed a registration statement for a new renewable energy facility. The registration statement included certified attestations that: (1) the facility is in substantial compliance with all federal and state laws, regulations, and rules for the protection of the environment and conservation of natural resources; (2) the facility will be operated as a new renewable energy facility; (3) the Applicant will not remarket or otherwise resell any renewable energy certificates sold to an electric power supplier to comply with G.S. 62-133.8; and (4) the Applicant will consent to the auditing of its books and records by the Public Staff insofar as those records relate to transactions with North Carolina electric power suppliers.

On July 1, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Requiring Publication of Notice.

On July 11, 2016, the Applicant filed an amended Application that corrected the location of the facility and provided verification of site control for the facility.

On July 12, 2016, the Commission issued an Amended Order Requiring Publication of Notice.

On July 20, 2016, the Applicant filed an amended Application that corrected some minor miscellaneous items.

On July 6 and July 20, 2016, the Applicant filed a certificate of service. The July 20, 2016 filing stated that a copy of the Application and the related public notice were provided to DEC on July 15, 2016.

On August 10, 2016, the Applicant filed an affidavit of publication from Statesville Record & Landmark stating that the publication of notice was completed on August 5, 2016. No complaints have been received.

On August 11, August 23, and August 26, 2016, the State Clearinghouse filed comments. Because of the nature of the comments, the cover letters indicated that no further State Clearinghouse review action by the Commission was required for compliance with the North Carolina Environmental Policy Act.

On September 9, 2016, the Applicant filed an amended registration statement verifying that the facility will be operated as a new renewable energy facility.

The Public Staff presented this matter to the Commission at its Regular Staff Conference on October 10, 2016. The Public Staff stated that it had reviewed the application and determined it to be in compliance with the requirements of G.S. 62-110.1(a) and Commission Rule R8-64. The Public Staff further stated that the registration statement contains the certified attestations required by Commission Rule R8-66(b). Therefore, the Public Staff recommended approval of the certificate and registration for the facility.

After careful consideration, the Commission finds good cause to approve the application and issue the attached certificate for the proposed solar photovoltaic electric generating facility. The Commission further finds good cause, based upon the foregoing and the entire record in this proceeding, to accept registration of the facility as a new renewable energy facility. The Applicant shall annually file the information required by Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year and will be required to participate in the NC-RETS REC tracking system (<a href="http://www.ncrets.org">http://www.ncrets.org</a>) in order to facilitate the issuance of RECs.

### IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the application of Tomlin Mill Solar, LLC, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity shall be, and is hereby, approved.
- 2. That Appendix A shall constitute the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Tomlin Mill Solar, LLC, for the 5-MW<sub>AC</sub> solar generating facility to be located approximately 4,200 feet east of the intersection of Tomlin Mill Road and Interstate 77, Statesville, Iredell County, North Carolina.
- 3. That the registration statement filed by Tomlin Mill Solar, LLC, for its solar photovoltaic facility located in Iredell County, North Carolina, as a new renewable energy facility, shall be, and is hereby, accepted.

4.	That Tomlin Mill Solar, LLC, shall annually file the information required by
Commission Rule R8-66 on or before April 1 of each year.
