NOW COMES NC WARN with a report on its activities under its power purchase agreement (PPA) with the Faith Community Church. On August 28, 2015, NC WARN sent its first invoice to the Church for the time period of June 30 through August 27. During that period the solar system on the Church's roof produced 1423 kWh, as determined through logging into the computerized monitoring system. The invoice was for the 1423 kWh (at a rate of \$0.05/kWh) for \$71.15, plus tax of \$5.34 (at rate of 7.5%), for a total due of \$76.49.
