Dear Ms. Campbell:

By this electronic filing, Aqua North Carolina, Inc. ("Aqua" or "Company") hereby provides Item 18 updates and associated supporting data to the Commission and the Public Staff pursuant to Ordering Paragraph Number 6 of the Commission's February 14, 2020 Rate Case Scheduling Order. The Ordering Paragraph provides as follows:

6. That Aqua's updates to its actual revenues, expenses, rate base, and cost of capital for the period ending March 31, 2020, shall be filed on or before Tuesday, April 21, 2020. This requirement shall not apply to events that are neither foreseeable nor within the Company's control. This requirement shall not prevent the Company from providing evidence showing changes in costs, including plant in service additions, pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-133(c).

In addition, Aqua hereby files certain updates to Items 16 and 19 of the Company's initial NCUC Rate Case Form W-1 compliance filing.

By this letter, I hereby certify that this filing has been served on the Public Staff; the only current party of record to this proceeding.
