ORDER GRANTING FURTHER  
EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE CHAIRMAN: On December 7, 2018, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket granting Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (Companies), and all other interested persons, an extension of time to Thursday, January 17, 2019, to file initial comments and to Thursday, January 31, 2019, to file reply comments.

On January 16, 2019, the Companies, filed a request for a further extension of time until February 7, 2019, for all parties to file initial comments and until February 21, 2019, for all parties to file reply comments. The Companies state that they are continuing to review the proposed programs with Public Staff and additional time may allow for consensus on outstanding issues. The Companies have conferred with all parties of record and no party has advised that it objects to the motion for the extension of time.


