BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On October 26, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Granting Further Extension of Time, which in part required the Public Staff to file supplemental testimony on or before November 16, 2020, regarding the application of Sumac Solar, LLC (Applicant) for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct a 120-MW solar photovoltaic facility in Bertie County, North Carolina. The Order also provided the Applicant an opportunity to file reply testimony and exhibits on or before November 30, 2020.

On November 20, 2020, the Applicant filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the procedural schedule for this proceeding. In support of its motion, the Applicant states that PJM Interconnection (PJM) recently informed the Applicant that Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), now expects to provide Affected System Study results relating to the Applicant's facility in late December 2020 or early January 2021. PJM also stated that it intends to provide the Applicant a revised System Impact Study during the same time period. In its motion, the Applicant further notes that the interconnection studies are of critical importance to the consideration of its CPCN application.

In the motion the Applicant requests that the Commission allow supplemental testimony and exhibits of the Applicant to be filed on or before Monday, February 22, 2021, the testimony and exhibits of Public Staff to be filed on or before Monday, March 8, 2021, and the reply testimony and exhibits of the Applicant to be filed on or before Monday, March 22, 2021.

The Applicant states in its motion that the Public Staff does not object to the requested extension.

Based on the filings of the parties and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the extension to file testimony. The Applicant shall file additional supplemental testimony and exhibits on or before February 22, 2021, the Public Staff

shall file testimony and exhibits on or before March 8, 2021, and the Applicant shall file reply testimony and exhibits on or before March 22, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
