BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 28, 2013, in response to a motion filed by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, Inc. (Movants), the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension of Time in the above-referenced docket. The Order extended the time for the electric public utilities (IOUs) to file 2013 updated integrated resource plans (IRPs), and related 2013 Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard (REPS) compliance plans from the original due date of September 3, 2013, to October 1, 2013.

On September 23, 2013, the Movants filed a Motion for Further Extension of Time requesting that the Commission extend the due date for their IRPs and REPS compliance plans to October 15, 2013. In support of their motion the Movants state, among other things, that they are conducting additional modeling for their updated IRPs and that incorporating the additional modeling into their IRPs is taking more time than initially anticipated. Therefore, the Movants need a further extension of the due date for filing their IRPs.

Based upon the record and the Movants' motion, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the date on which the IOUs shall file their 2013 updated IRPs and 2013 REPS compliance plans to October 15, 2013.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
