On October 20, 2017, NC GreenPower filed a request to extend the duration of its 50/50 Hybrid Program from three to four years to continue gathering data to analyze the impact of the Solar Schools initiative. NC GreenPower also agreed to submit a summary report on Pilot Year 3 by the end of December 2017.

The Public Staff has no objection to continuation of the 50/50 Hybrid Program for a fourth year and submission of a report by the end of Year Three. The Public Staff recommends that NC GreenPower also be required to file a report on Year Four by the end of December 2018.
