Briar Chapel community is roughly 75% complete. There is a small amount of additional residential development to be completed and a more significant amount of commercial development. ONSWC is expanding the capacity of the WWTP to accommodate the completion of this development as required by our developer, NNP Briar Chapel, LLC (Newland Communities) in their 10/31/2014 Purchase Agreement (starting on Pg. 49).

We agree with Mr. McDonald of ONSWC, the new development which is driving these upgrades should help offset the capital costs for this upgrade with an increase in the connection fees from \$1,500 to \$4,000 per residential equivalent units (REUs).
