### SECOND AMENDMENT TO UTILITY ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO UTILITY ASSET PURCHASE AGREEMENT (this "Second Amendment") is entered into as of January 24, 2019 (the "Effective Date") by and between PACE UTILITIES GROUP, INC., a North Carolina corporation (the "Seller") and CAROLINA WATER SERVICE, INC. OF NORTH CAROLINA, a North Carolina corporation (the "Purchaser").

#### WITNESSESTH

WHEREAS, Seller and Purchaser entered into that certain Utility Asset Purchase Agreement with an Effective Date of August 6, 2018 (the "Agreement;" capitalized but undefined words contained herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement);

WHEREAS, Seller and Purchaser entered into an Amendment to Utility Asset Purchase Agreement with an Effective Date of November 19, 2018 (the "Amendment");

WHEREAS, Seller has completed its due diligence of the Purchased Assets comprising Seller's Utility System; and

WHEREAS, Seller and Purchaser desire to further amend the Agreement as provided herein;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreements of the parties set forth herein, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement by replacing *in toto* original Section 2.04 in the Agreement with new SECTION 2.04. PURCHASER PRICE as follows:

- 1. SECTION 2.04. PURCHASE PRICE. (A) The Purchase Price for the Purchased Assets is an amount equal to FORTY-THREE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$43,000.00) subject to prorations and adjustments set forth in this Agreement. The Purchase Price shall be payable by Buyer to Seller in immediately available funds at Closing, by wire transfer, pursuant to wire instructions to be provided by Seller to Buyer at or prior to Closing. (B) To the extent the NCUC establishes the rate base for the Purchased Assets below the Purchase Price, Buyer shall have the option, at its sole discretion, to terminate the Agreement without further liability or obligation to the Seller under this Agreement. To be effective, any notice of termination must be given by Buyer to Seller within thirty (30) days after the NCUC enters its Order establishing the rate base for the Purchased Assets.
- Effect. Upon execution of this Second Amendment by Seller and Purchaser, this Second Amendment shall be deemed a modification of the Agreement and the Amendment. However, except as expressly modified hereby, all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement and the Amendment shall remain unaltered and remain in full force and effect.
- 3. <u>Miscellaneous.</u> This Second Amendment may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall constitute an original. The parties may sign this Second Amendment by telefaxed or PDF copies, any of such telefaxed or PDF copies shall be deemed an original, and no objection shall be made to the introduction into evidence of any telefaxed or PDF copies on grounds relating to the copy not being an original.
