CONTINUING HEARING	

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 1, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Granting Extension to Time to File Testimony in the above-captioned proceeding rescheduling the expert witness hearing in this proceeding to begin on Tuesday, January 26, 2021, and establishing deadlines for parties to file direct and rebuttal testimony.

On November 10, 2020, Cube Yadkin Generation, LLC (Complainant), Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Respondents; collectively, the Parties), filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission extend the procedural schedule by approximately 30 days. The Parties request that the direct testimony and exhibits of Complainant be due on or before Thursday, December 10, 2020, that the direct testimony and exhibits of Respondents be due on or before Monday, January 11, 2021, and that Complainant's rebuttal testimony and exhibits be due on or before Friday, February 12, 2021. The Parties further request that the hearing be rescheduled to begin no sooner than Monday, March 1, 2021.

The Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the requested extension of time for the Parties to prefile testimony and exhibits and to continue the hearing.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That the hearing solely for the purpose of receiving the expert witness testimony of the parties currently scheduled for January 26, 2021, shall be continued and rescheduled by further order of the Commission;
- 2. That Complainant shall file its direct testimony and exhibits no later than Thursday, December 10, 2020;

- 3. That Respondents shall file their direct testimony and exhibits no later than Monday, January 11, 2021; and
- 4. That Complainant may file rebuttal testimony and exhibits, if any, no later than Friday, February 12, 2021.
