BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On April 16, 2020, in Docket No. M-100, Sub 158 the Commission suspended pending further order the provisions of Commission Rules R1-5(g), R1-28, and any other rules requiring persons electronically filing certain documents with the Commission to additionally provide the Chief Clerk's Office with paper copies of such filings (Suspension Order).

- 1. That the Suspension Order is hereby superseded by this Order only for this rate case proceeding, Docket No. W-218, Sub 526;
- 2. That all parties to this docket are hereby required to provide to the Chief Clerk's Office as soon as possible, but not later than June 16, 2020, paper copies of any and all documents, not previously filed, that would have been required to be filed in this docket pursuant to Commission Rules R1-5(g), R1-28, and any other rules requiring persons electronically filing certain documents with the Commission to additionally provide the Chief Clerk's Office with paper copies of such filings; and
- 3. That the Chief Clerk will contact each party to this docket to arrange a time for delivery of all required paper filings, and that each party will strive to deliver to the

Chief Clerk all required paper filings at one time to avoid the need for additional delivery appointments to the greatest extent possible.
