BY THE CHAIR: On September 9, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Reply Comments on the comments filed by Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association (CCEBA) on September 8, 2021. The CCEBA comments were in response to the Petition for Approval of Limited Modifications to the North Carolina Interconnection Procedures to Expand Transitional Cluster Study Eligibility (Petition) filed by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (together, Duke) on August 17, 2021. In the Petition, Duke proposes modifications to the Transitional Cluster Study process that is part of the queue reform transition process.

On September 15, 2021, Duke filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Comments. In its Motion, Duke stated that as part of the development of an accelerated CPRE Tranche 3 RFP, Duke and the CPRE Independent Administrator have scheduled a stakeholder meeting for September 17, 2021, to discuss issues concerning the CPRE Tranche 3 schedule and the integration of CPRE Tranche 3 into the Transitional Cluster Study process. In its Motion, Duke requests an extension of six days to file reply comments as CCEBA's comments on the Petition are largely focused on CPRE Tranche 3's integration with the Transitional Cluster Study Process. Duke further states in its Motion that the Public Staff, Dominion Energy North Carolina, the Attorney General's Office, ElectriCities, CCEBA, and the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association do not object to its Motion.

Based on the motion and the entire record, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension. Parties may file comments on the CCEBA's proposed modifications on or before Wednesday, September 22, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
