ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On December 14, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Procedural Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice in the above captioned docket. The Order required the Applicant's rebuttal testimony to be filed on or before April 12, 2021.

On April 12, 2021, Oak Trail Solar, LLC (Applicant) filed a motion requesting an extension of time to file its rebuttal testimony and exhibits on or before April 21, 2021. In its motion, the Applicant noted that the Public Staff filed testimony on March 21, 2021, recommending that the Commission issue the Applicant's requested certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) subject to certain conditions. The Applicant states in the motion that it requires additional time to continue discussions with the Public Staff regarding potential revisions to the Public Staff's recommended conditions to the CPCN. The Applicant further stated that the Public Staff does not object to the requested extension.

Based on the motion and the record as a whole, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the filing date for the Applicant's rebuttal testimony and exhibits to on or before April 21, 2021.
