BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 11, 2019, this matter came on for hearing as scheduled. Prior to the close of the hearing, the Presiding Commissioner directed the parties to file proposed orders and briefs in this docket within 30 days of the transcript of the hearing being made available to the parties. Pursuant to that direction, the parties' proposed orders and briefs are due to be filed on or before July 29, 2019.

On July 23, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion seeking a 7-day extension of time for all parties to file proposed orders and briefs. In support of its motion, the Public Staff states that it and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, are working to file a joint proposed order, but the drafting of that proposed order will require additional time beyond the July 29, 2019 deadline. The Public Staff furthers states that no other party to this docket objects to the granting of the requested extension of time.

The Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the Public Staff's requested extension of time, thereby establishing August 5, 2019, as the deadline for the parties to file proposed orders and briefs.
