BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 21, 2017, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC) filed an application in the above-captioned docket for approval of DEC's proposed Residential New Construction Program.

On January 27, 2020, the Commission held a hearing in this docket. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Presiding Commissioner directed that the parties file briefs and proposed orders within thirty (30) days.
