BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On August 10, 2021, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned docket regarding an annual review of the gas costs of Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC). Briefs and proposed orders of the parties are due on October 4, 2021.

On October 1, 2021, PSNC and the Public Staff (Movants), filed a joint motion requesting that the date for filing briefs and proposed orders be extended to October 11, 2021. In summary, Movants stated that they are working diligently to prepare their proposed orders and/or briefs, but due to the press of other business they require additional time to finalize their proposed orders and/or briefs. In addition, Movants stated that they contacted counsel for Haw River Assembly, the only other party to this proceeding, and that Haw River Assembly does not object to the requested extension of time.


Based on Movants' motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the due date for all parties to file briefs and proposed orders to October 11, 2021.
