The North Carolina Attorney General's Office ("Attorney General's Office" or "AGO"), through the undersigned, moves for an extension of time in which to give notice of cross appeal to the Commission's Order Accepting Public Staff Stipulation in Part, Accepting CIGFUR Stipulation, Deciding Contested Issues, and Granting Partial Rate Increase issued 24 February 2020 (the "24 February 2020 Order"), in the above-captioned matter. In support thereof, the Attorney General's Office states the following:

1. On 29 July 2020, Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina ("Dominion") filed notice of appeal and exceptions pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a) to the Commission's 24 February 2020 Order in this case. The notice of appeal was filed one day after the Commission issued its Order Deciding Motions for Reconsideration and Clarification, and Requiring Implementation of New Rates on 28 July 2020.
2. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-90(a), notice of cross appeal must be filed within 20 days after the first notice of appeal and exceptions has been filed, "or within such time
