HEARING EXAMINER FENNEL: Good morning.

I'm Heather Fennell, Staff Attorney for the Utilities Commission, and the Hearing Examiner for this proceeding.

I now call for hearing Docket Number E-22, Sub 590, which is the Application by Dominion Energy North Carolina, Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute § 62-133.2 and Commission Rule R8-55 Regarding Fuel and Fuel-Related Charge for Adjustments -- Fuel-Related Charge Adjustments for Electric Utilities.
