3	come to order and go on the record. I am Commissioner		
4	ToNola D. Brown-Bland, presiding commissioner for this		
5	hearing, and with me this evening are Chairman Edward S.

9	I now call for hearing Docket Number G-5, Sub		
10	565, In the Matter of an Application of Public Service		
11	Company of North Carolina, Inc., for a General Increase

13	On February 17, 2016, Public Service Company of		
14	North Carolina, Inc., here hereafter Company or PSNC,		
15	gave notice of its intent to file an Application for a		
16	General Rate Increase.		
17	On March 3rd, 2016, Carolina Utility Customers		
18	Association, Inc., CUCA, filed a Petition to Intervene		
19	and an order granting the petition was issued by the		
20	Commission on March 7th, 2016.		
21	On March 31st, 2016, PSNC filed an Application,		
22	direct testimony and exhibits requesting authority to		
23	increase its rates and charges and to make various		
24	changes to its terms and conditions of service.		

North Carolina Utilities Commission

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1	On April 26th, 2016, the Commission issued an
2	Order Scheduling Investigation and Hearing, Suspending
3	Proposed Rates, Establishing Intervention and Testimony
4	Due Dates and Discovery Guidelines and Requiring Public
5	Notice. Pursuant to the order, this general rate case
6	was scheduled for public hearing starting last night in
7	Gastonia; tonight, August 24th, 2016, in Asheville;
8	August 25th in Statesville, and in Raleigh on August 29th
9	for the purpose of taking public witness testimony on the
10	application. The Commission's order also scheduled an
11	evidentiary hearing on the application for Tuesday,
12	August 30th, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing
13	Room in Raleigh. At that time the Commission will
14	receive any additional public witness testimony, followed
15	by the expert witness testimony of the parties.
16	On May 31st, 2016, Evergreen Packaging filed a
17	Petition to Intervene which was granted by the Commission
18	on June 2nd, 2016.
19	On June 13th, 2016, the Attorney General filed
20	a Notice of Intervention recognized pursuant to G.S. 62-
21	20.
22	The intervention and participation of the
23	Public Staff of the North Carolina Utilities Commission
24	is recognized pursuant to G.S. 62-15(d) and Commission

Rule R1-19(e). 1 On June 16, 2016, PSNC filed Affidavits of 2 Publication of Public Notice, and on June 23rd, 2016, 3 PSNC filed certification that it had provided notice of 4 hearing to each of its customers. 5 On August 18, 2016, PSNC, CUCA, Evergreen 6 Packaging and the Public Staff filed a Partial 7 Stipulation. 8 On August 18, 2016, the Public Staff filed 9 direct testimony. 10 Pursuant to G.S. 138A-15(e), I remind the 11 members of the Commission of our duty to avoid conflicts 12 of interest and inquire at this time as to whether any 13 commissioner has any known conflict of interest with 14 respect to this docket? (No response.) 15 Let the record reflect there were no conflicts 16 identified. 17 I now call on the parties to announce their 18 participa--- their appearance for the record, and we'll 19 start with the Applicant. 20 MS. GRIGG: Good evening, Commissioner Brown-21 Bland, members of the Commission. I am Mary Lynne Grigg 22 with the law firm of McGuireWoods, appearing on behalf of 23 24 PSNC.

COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: Good evening. 1 MR. COLLINS: Good evening. Craig Collins, 2 Associate General Counsel for SCANA, and I'm also here on 3 behalf of PSNC. 4 COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: Good evening, Mr. 5 Collins. 6 MS. WIKE: Good evening. May it please the 7 Commission, I'm Antoinette Wike with the Public Staff, 8 representing the Using and Consuming Public. 9 COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: All right. Ms. 10 Wike, I look around, I don't see any public witnesses 11 here. Have you identified any? 12 MS.
