BY THE CHAIR: On September 14, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearing, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, And Requiring Public Notice (Scheduling Order). The Scheduling Order required the Public Staff and other intervenors to file testimony and exhibits in the fuel charge adjustment proceeding of Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC or Company) on or before Monday, October 26, 2020.

On October 26, 2020, the Public Staff filed a Motion for an Extension of Time, requesting to file its testimony and exhibits in this docket on or before November 2, 2020. In support of its motion the Public Staff notes that the Company filed a Petition for Waiver of Notice Requirements due to errors discovered in the Company testimony that resulted in the overall reduction in the fuel recovery being understated in the first notice. This error results in a change in the proposed fuel rider amount for each customer class. The Public Staff further states that it is working with the Company to correct the errors, requests additional time to file its testimony and exhibits in this proceeding, and requests a corresponding one-week extension for DENC to file its rebuttal testimony.

The Public Staff states in its motion that Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utilities Rates I and DENC do not oppose the motion.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to November 2, 2020, the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct

testimony, and the to extend the date to November 9, 2020, the date for DENC to file rebuttal testimony.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
