



4. The AGO requires additional time to complete its brief and requests that the Commission approve an extension of two (2) business days up to and including Wednesday, November 4, 2020, to file and serve its brief and/or proposed order.

5. The undersigned communicated with Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and asked whether DEC would object to a one-week extension, and DEC responded that it would agree to a two-day extension but would oppose a longer one. Other parties were contacted shortly before this filing was prepared and the Public Staff, CBA/AV, CIGFUR, Commercial Group, CUCA, Harris Teeter, NCCEBA, NCJC et al., NCLM, NCSEA, NC Warn, Sierra Club, Tech Customers, and Vote Solar stated that they do not object to the requested extension. Further, no other intervenors have responded with any objections to the requested extension.

Wherefore, the Attorney General's Office respectfully requests an extension of the deadline by an additional two (2) days, up to and including Wednesday November 4, 2020, for parties to file briefs and/or proposed orders.
