BY THE CHAIR: On October 7, 2019, in the above-captioned proceeding, the Commission issued a Notice of Decision, giving notice of the Commission's decisions on certain issues in dispute in this proceeding. It has come to the Commission's attention that decision number 15 erroneously referenced the fuel forecasting approach used "in the 2018 biennial avoided cost proceeding."

The Chair finds good cause to issue this Errata Order revising decision number 15 in the October 7 Notice of Decision to accurately reflect the Commission's intent to announce its decision that the fuel forecasting approach used in the 2016 biennial avoided cost proceeding should continue to be used in calculating DEC and DEP's respective avoided energy rates in this proceeding.
