NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, the “Companies”), pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7(a)(5) and the *Order Requiring Filing of Proposed Orders*, issued by the North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Commission”) in these dockets on December 17, 2019, and respectfully move the Commission for a three-week extension of time to February 24, 2020 for all parties to file proposed orders in the above-captioned dockets. In support of their motion, the Companies show as follows:

1. On March 29, 2019, the Companies filed an application requesting approval of the proposed Electric Transportation Pilot Program (“ET Pilot”).
2. On April 4, 2019, the Commission issued an order directing parties to file comments and reply comments on the ET Pilot. The Commission received statements of position from interested persons as well as comments and reply comments from numerous parties.
3. On November 21, 2019, the Commission held a hearing on the ET Pilot.
4. On December 17, 2019, the Commission issued the *Order Requiring Filing of Proposed Orders*, directing the Companies and the Public Staff to file proposed orders on or before February 3, 2020.


5. The Companies have been working diligently to prepare their proposed order but, due to the press of other business, require additional time to complete their proposed order. Based on the foregoing, the Companies respectfully request an extension of three weeks, up to and including February 24, 2020, for all parties to file proposed orders in these proceedings.

6. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.

7. Counsel for the Companies have contacted counsel for all parties of record regarding this requested extension, and no party has advised that it objects.

WHEREFORE, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission issue an order extending the time to February 24, 2020 for all parties to file proposed orders, and such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
