NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP" and together with DEC, "Duke" or "Movants") pursuant to Commission Rule R1-7 and respectfully move the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission" or "NCUC") for an extension of time through and including May 20, 2019, for parties to file comments on North Carolina Clean Energy Business Association's ("NCCEBA") May 1, 2019 Motion for Reconsideration, and, correspondingly, an extension of time through and including May 27, 2019, for NCCEBA to file reply comments, as allowed by the Commission's May 6, 2019 *Order Requesting Comments* ("Order"). In support of this Motion, the Movants respectfully show the Commission as follows:

- 1. On January 22, 2018, DEP and DEC jointly filed their proposed Green Source Advantage program and Rider GSA in the above-captioned dockets.
- 2. On January 26, 2018, the Commission issued its *Order Establishing Proceeding to Review Proposed Green Source Rider Advantage Program and Rider GSA*.
- 3. On February 1, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Modifying and Approving Green Source Advantage Program, Requiring Compliance Filing, and Allowing Comments* ("GSA Program Order").

- 4. On March 18, 2019, Duke made its Compliance Filing pursuant to the Commission's *GSA Program Order*.
- 5. On March 27, 2019, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA") filed a Motion for Extension of Time, which was subsequently granted by the Commission on March 28, 2019.
- 6. On April 8, 2019, the North Carolina Utilities Commission—Public Staff ("Public Staff"), NCCEBA, the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy ("SACE"), and NCSEA filed comments on Duke's Compliance Filing.
  - 7. On April 18, 2019, Duke filed reply comments.
- 8. On May 1, 2019, NCCEBA filed a motion pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 62-80 requesting that the Commission reconsider certain finding and conclusions made in the Commission's *GSA Program Order* related to Duke's and potential Duke affiliates' participation in the Green Source Advantage Program.
- 9. On May 6, 2019, the Commission issued its *Order Requesting Comments*, requesting parties to file comments in the above-captioned dockets regarding NCCEBA's May 1, 2019 Motion on or before May 13, 2019, and for NCCEBA to file any reply comments on or before May 20, 2019.
- 10. Duke is working diligently to meet the May 13, 2019 comments deadline. However, given the significant time Duke has committed to other matters currently pending before the Commission, additional time is required for Duke to finalize their comments, and, correspondingly, additional time should be allowed for NCCEBA to file reply comments.

- 11. Based on the foregoing, the Movants request an extension of time through and including Monday, May 20, 2019, for all parties to file comments, and an extension of time through and including Monday, May 27, 2019, for NCCEBA to file reply comments in this proceeding.
- 12. The undersigned counsel for Duke has contacted counsel for NCCEBA and the Public Staff regarding this Motion via telephone and/or electronic mail, and these parties have each agreed to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC respectfully request that the Commission grant this Motion for an extension of time through and including Monday, May 20, 2019, for parties to file comments regarding NCCEBA's Motion for Reconsideration of the Commission's February 1, 2019 *Order Modifying and Approving Green Source Advantage Program, Requiring Compliance Filing, and Allowing Comments*, and, correspondingly, an extension of time through and including Monday, May 27, 2019, for NCCEBA to file reply comments.
