BY THE COMMISSION: On August 28, 2019, the Commission held a Technical Conference for the purpose of obtaining additional information from Duke Energy Progress, LLC, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (collectively Duke), and the Public Staff on the subject of Integrated Systems and Operations Planning (ISOP), in particular as it relates to Duke's integrated resource planning.

On October 23, 2019, Duke filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission and interested parties that Duke will hold an ISOP Workshop on December 10, 2019, in Raleigh, North Carolina. Duke stated that the Workshop is a next step to continue discussions with stakeholders about ISOP, and it invited interested persons to attend.

The Commission appreciates Duke's effort in organizing the ISOP Workshop. In addition, the Commission would find it helpful for Duke and the Public Staff to file a report with the Commission summarizing the stakeholders' discussions at the Workshop, any conclusions reached by the participants, and Duke's next steps for further discussions about ISOP.


Therefore, the Commission finds good cause to direct that Duke and the Public Staff file a joint report on the ISOP Workshop on or before January 22, 2020.
