BY THE CHAIR: On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket initiating a rulemaking on access to electric customer usage data. On April 2, 2019, the Commission issued an Order extending the date for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to June 14, 2019.

On June 11, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting a further extension of time to July 29, 2019, for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules. In summary, the Public Staff stated that it has drafted proposed rules and it shared those with the parties on June 7, 2019. The Public Staff stated that it would like the opportunity to discuss the proposed rules with the parties. In addition, the Public Staff stated that it informed all parties to this proceeding of its motion for extension of time and that several parties indicated that they do not oppose the motion. Finally, the Public Staff stated that no party indicated that it would oppose the motion.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to July 29, 2019.
