P1. DOCKET NO. G-5, SUB 605 - APPLICATION OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY
OF NORTH CAROLINA, INC., FOR APPROVAL OF TEMPORARY
INCREMENTS APPLICABLE TO ITS ALL CUSTOMERS DEFERRED ACCOUNT
UNDER RIDER D TO ITS TARIFF

EXPLANATION: On April 17, 2019, Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC or Company), filed an application (Application) pursuant to N. C. Gen. Stat. § 62-133.4 and Commission Rule R1-17(k)(5)(d), seeking authority to implement temporary rate increments applicable to its All Customers Deferred Account, effective for service rendered on and after May 1, 2019. Rider D of the Company's tariff requires PSNC to file a revision to its tariff for Commission approval to implement temporary decrements or increments to current rates in order to refund or collect balances in its cost of gas deferred accounts.

Pursuant to Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Docket No. RP18-1126, Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Company, LLC implemented revised tariffs effective March 1, 2019. Because of these increased rates, PSNC's annual fixed gas costs will increase by approximately \$14.5 million. Accordingly, in Docket No. G-5, Sub 604, PSNC requested and the Commission approved discontinuance of the temporary decrements applicable to the All Customers Deferred Account.

PSNC states that although the balance in the All Customers Deferred Account as of March 31, 2019, is an over-collection of \$3,040,186, it is projected to be an under-collection at the end of May. Without implementation of the proposed increments, PSNC projects that the balance would remain an under-collection through the end of March 2020. Therefore, PSNC proposes to implement temporary rate increments described in detail in Schedule A and Schedule B of its Application to address this anticipated under-collection.

The Public Staff has reviewed these proposed rate adjustments and recommends approval as filed.

RECOMMENDATION: (Naba) That the Commission issue the proposed order approving PSNC's proposed temporary rate changes as filed.

EXPLANATION: On March 29, 2019, Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina, filed an application with the Commission requesting authority to adjust and increase its rates for retail electric service in North Carolina effective on May 1, 2019.

The Public Staff recommends that an order be issued establishing a general rate case and suspending rates.

BY THE COMMISSION: On April 17, 2019, Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc. (PSNC or Company), filed an application (Application) pursuant to N.C. Gen. - 1. That PSNC is authorized to implement the temporary rate increments applicable to its All Customers' Deferred Account detailed in Schedule A and Schedule B of its Application, effective for service rendered on and after May 1, 2019.
- 2. That PSNC shall file revised tariffs consistent with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 within five (5) days of the date of this Order.
- 3. That PSNC shall give notice to its customers of the temporary rate changes authorized by this Order.
