BY THE CHAIRMAN: On July 6, 2017, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, established September 5, 2017, as the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony and exhibits (testimony).

On September 5, 2017, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend the date for the filing of direct testimony to September 7, 2017. The Public Staff states that it has been informed by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP) that DEP intends to file supplemental testimony on September 5 or 6, 2017, amending its application to reflect a significant increase in DEP's projected fuel and fuel-related costs. As a result, the Public Staff needs additional time to review DEP's supplemental testimony and to prepare its testimony. Further, the Public Staff states that DEP does not object to the requested extension of time, and the Public Staff does not believe that the extension will prejudice any other party.


Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chairman finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file direct testimony to September 7, 2017.
