BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On May 19, 2021, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, scheduled a public witness hearing to be held via remote means on June 17, 2021, and set a deadline for registration to testify at the public witness hearing as no later than 5:00 p.m. on June 2, 2021.

On June 11, 2021, the Public Staff (Movant) filed a motion requesting that the public witness hearing be canceled. Movant states that Clarke Utilities, Inc., filed a certificate of service on May 25, 2021, indicating that all of its customers had been served with notice of the proposed rate increase and hearing. Movant states that it did not receive any protests, and no one registered to provide testimony at the public hearing by the deadline and requests that, therefore, the public witness hearing be canceled.

Based on Movant's motion and the record, the Commission finds good cause to cancel the public witness hearing scheduled for Thursday, June 17, 2021.
