I now call for hearing Docket Number W-218, Sub 526, In the Matter of Application by Aqua North Carolina, Inc., 202 MacKenan Court, Cary, North Carolina 27511, for Authority to Increase Rates for Water and Sewer Utility Service in All of Its Service Areas in North Carolina.

Pursuant to the State Government Ethics Act,

On December 31st, 2019, Aqua North Carolina, Inc., Aqua or Company, filed an Application with the Commission seeking authority to increase its rates for water and sewer utility service in all of its service areas in North Carolina.

On February 14th, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Establishing General Rate Case, Scheduling Hearings and Requiring Customer Notice.

The Order scheduled six public hearings throughout the Company's service territory for the purpose of hearing from customers regarding the Company's Application and quality of service, and scheduled a hearing in Raleigh to begin on June 23rd, 2020 at 9:30 a.m. for the purpose of receiving testimony from the parties' expert witnesses.

By Order of the Commission issued on March 31, 2020, the public hearings were postponed following issuance of Governor Roy Cooper's Executive Order No. 116 which declared a State of Emergency in North Carolina to coordinate responsive and protective actions to prevent the spread of Coronavirus, COVID-19, and which restricted public gatherings in an effort to contain the spread of the Coronavirus. The postponed public hearings will be rescheduled in the near future by Order of the Commission.

In the continuing effort to comply with the March 31 Executive Order and subsequent Executive Orders designed to have state residents and state agencies limit unnecessary person-to-person contact in work places and other locations where people gather, the Presiding Commissioner has excused the witnesses and counsel for the Company and the intervening party
