BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 20, 2019, the Commission issued an Order scheduling the above-captioned matter for hearing on Monday, September 9, 2019.

On September 5, 2019, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, and the Public Staff (collectively, Movants), filed a joint motion requesting that the Commission excuse several witnesses from attending the hearing. DEP requested that witness Carolyn T. Miller be excused, and the Public Staff requested that witnesses Michael C. Maness and David Williamson be excused. Movants stated that all parties in this docket have agreed to waive cross-examination of these witnesses, and offer no objection to the introduction of the witnesses' testimony and exhibits into the record.


Based on the foregoing and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant Movants' motion to excuse DEP witness Carolyn T. Miller, and Public Staff witness Michael C. Maness from attending the hearing on September 9, 2019, and to receive their testimony and exhibits into evidence at the hearing. However, Movants' motion to excuse Public Staff witness David Williamson is denied.
