2 HEARING EXAMINER FENNELL: Good morning.
3 Let's come to order, please, and go on the record. My
4 name is Heather Fennell. I'm a Staff Attorney with
5 the Utilities Commission, and I'm the Hearing Examiner
6 for this proceeding.

7 I now call for hearing Docket Number E-22,
8 Sub 589, which is the Application by Dominion Energy
9 North Carolina, for Approval of Demand-Side Management
10 and Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Rider Pursuant to
11 N.C. General Statute § 62-133.9 and Commission Rule
12 R8-69.

13 On August 11, 2020, Dominion Energy North
14 Carolina, filed its Application to address the
15 approval of cost recovery for its Demand-Side
16 Management and Energy Efficiency Programs.

17 We are here this morning to accept public
18 witness testimony.
