- 3 A. The purpose of my supplemental testimony is to recommend a bond
- 4 amount.

5 Q. WHAT AMOUNT OF BOND DOES THE PUBLIC STAFF

6 **RECOMMEND?**

- 7 A. In LJA's original franchise Docket No. W-1274, Sub 0, in 2007, the
- 8 Commission approved the minimum bond in the amount of \$20,000
- 9 for water and sewer. The minimum bond amount of \$10,000 was
- 10 established with the enactment of N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-100.3 in
- 11 1987, more than 30 years ago. The Public Staff recommends that
- Lake Junaluska Assembly, Inc. (LJA) be required to post a \$50,000
- bond to comply with N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-110.3. LJA purchases bulk
- water and sewage treatment from the town of Waynesville. The water
- and sewer systems primarily consist of a water distribution system
- and a sewer collection system. As I have previously testified, the
- 17 Public Staff is in support of LJA's 10-Year capital improvement plan

- for main replacement and its proposed monthly surcharge. It is the
 Public Staff opinion that LJA is taken the necessary steps to replace
 its aging systems and that \$50,000 is sufficient.
