BY THE CHAIR: On February 4, 2019, the Commission issued an Order in the above-captioned docket initiating a rulemaking on access to electric customer usage data. On July 25, 2019, the Commission issued an Order Granting Third Extension of Time. The Order extended the date for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to September 12, 2019.

On September 10, 2019, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the date for filing comments and/or proposed rules be further extended to November 12, 2019. The Public Staff stated that additional time is needed to discuss the draft rules with other parties, which may allow consensus to be reached on outstanding issues. Further, the Public Staff stated that it contacted all the parties to this proceeding about the requested extension of time and all have indicated that they do not oppose the motion.


Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for parties to file initial comments and/or proposed rules to November 12, 2019.
