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BY THE CHAIR: On June 29, 2020, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, set the deadline for the filing of direct testimony and exhibits (testimony), of intervenors and the Public Staff for August 25, 2020, and the date for the rebuttal testimony of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), if any, as on or before September 3, 2020.

On August 24, 2020, Sierra Club filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend to August 27, 2020, the date for Sierra Club and other intervenors to file direct testimony. In summary, Sierra Club stated that said extension would allow Sierra Club sufficient time to review recently produced responses to data requests, and to finalize and file its testimony. In addition, Sierra Club stated that it contacted all other parties to this docket, that DEP requested an extension of four business days in which to file its rebuttal testimony, and that no other party raised an objection to Sierra Club's motion.

Based on Sierra Club's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend to August 27, 2020, the date for Sierra Club and other intervenors to file direct testimony, and to extend to September 10, 2020, the date for DEP to file rebuttal testimony.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
