BY THE CHAIR: On October 14, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments and Proposed Rules in the above captioned docket. The Order directed parties to file comments or proposed rules on or before November 9, 2021, and reply comments on or before December 7, 2021. Several parties filed comments or proposed rules on November 9, 2021.

On November 19, 2021, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP, and together with DEC, Duke) filed a Motion for Extension of Time to File Reply Comments. Duke requested an additional ten days to file comments, or until December 17, 2021. In its motion, Duke noted that it is working diligently to complete its reply comments, but due to the complexity of the matter it requests additional time to file the reply comments. Duke also notes that the additional time will be used to collaborate with other parties to identify potential areas of compromise. Duke further noted in its motion that it contacted counsel for all the other parties in the docket, and no other party objected to the requested extension.

Based on the motion and the record as a whole, the Chair finds good cause to grant the requested extension. All parties may have until December 17, 2021, to file reply comments.
