BY THE COMMISSION: On July 16, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Excusing Several Witnesses from Testifying at Expert Witness Hearings in the above-captioned dockets involving the general rate case applications of Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP). In summary, the Order excused some witnesses from testifying at the consolidated expert witness hearing that

is scheduled to begin on July 27, 2020, in these dockets, and from testifying at the separate DEC and DEP hearings to be scheduled for a later date.

It has come to the Commission's attention that the Order did not correctly identify the hearing from which Public Staff witness John Hinton has been excused from testifying. As a result, the Commission hereby amends its Order to state that Public Staff witness John Hinton is excused only from attending the separate hearing for DEC.
