BY THE CHAIR: On August 23, 2019, the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) filed the testimony of Michelle M. Boswell with one exhibit. Public Staff witness Boswell notes in her direct testimony on pages 5-6 that, "[t]he Public Staff recognizes in the present case that the total unprotected EDIT balance of \$5.928 million is a debit balance owed to the Company".

The Chair finds good cause to request that the Public Staff make a filing as soon as reasonably possible, providing an explanation as to why DENC's total unprotected EDIT has a debit balance, as a debit balance has not heretofore arisen in the Commission's consideration of EDIT issues related to the Federal Tax Act.
