BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 1, 2011, pursuant to Commission Rule R8-60, Progress Energy Carolinas, Inc., Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Dominion North Carolina Power filed annual integrated resource planning reports in the above-captioned docket.

On May 30, 2012, the Commission issued its Order Approving Annual Updates to 2010 Biennial Integrated Resource Plans and 2011 REPS Compliance Plans. The Order, however, questioned whether certain information designated as confidential by Dominion North Carolina Power (NC Power), in its 2011 REPS Compliance Plan (Plan), was properly marked as confidential and directed NC Power to make a compliance filing within 30 days explaining why it had designated the information as confidential.

On June 27, 2012, NC Power made a compliance filing stating that it had reexamined the information designated as confidential in its Plan, considered the points made in the Commission's Order and determined that much of the information designated as confidential should have been made public. Further, NC Power explained why certain information that it considers was properly designated as confidential in the Plan should remain confidential. Finally, NC Power filed revised public and confidential versions of the Plan in which it removed the confidential designation of the information that it determined should be made public.


After careful consideration of NC Power's compliance filing and the explanations contained therein, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to accept NC Power's explanations and to conclude that NC Power has fully complied with the Commission's Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
