NOW COME THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC), and, together, respectfully request that the Commission issue an order in the above-captioned docket excusing the Public Staff's and DENC's witnesses from appearing at the evidentiary hearing scheduled in this proceeding. In addition, the Public Staff and DENC jointly move the Commission to reschedule the evidentiary hearing to be held in this matter in Raleigh on Tuesday, November 22, 2021, in Commission Hearing Room 2115, to be conducted on the same date but by remote means.

In support of this motion, the Public Staff and DENC show as follows:

1. On August 10, 2021, DENC filed its Application for Approval of Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard Cost Recovery Rider (Application) along with the pre-filed testimony of George E. Hitch, Justin A. Wooldridge, and Emilia L. Catron in support of the Application.

- On August 23, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearing, Requiring Filing of Testimony, Establishing Discovery Guidelines, and Requiring Public Notice.
- 3. On August 25, 2021, Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates I (CIGFUR I) filed a Petition to Intervene. The Commission granted the petition on August 27, 2021.
- On September 1, 2021, Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc.
  (CUCA) filed a petition to intervene. The Commission granted the petition on September 3, 2021.
- 5. On October 14, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Rescheduling Expert Witness Hearings. The order rescheduled the expert witness hearing in this docket for Monday, November 22, 2021, beginning at 1:30 p.m. in Commission Hearing Room 2115, Dobbs Building, 430 Salisbury Street, Raleigh, North Carolina.
- 6. On October 15, 2021, DENC filed a Corrected Company Exhibit GEH-1.
- 7. On October 26, 2021, the Public Staff filed the affidavits of Jay B. Lucas and Charles A. Akpom.
  - 8. No other parties filed testimony in this proceeding.
  - 9. On November 1, 2021, DENC filed its Affidavit of Publication.

- 10. On November 8, 2021, DENC filed a Letter in Lieu of Rebuttal Testimony.
- 11. A review of the pre-filed testimony of DENC and the affidavits of the Public Staff indicates that the Public Staff and DENC are in agreement regarding DENC's REPS compliance and related costs. The Public Staff and DENC agree on DENC's Rider RP and Rider RPE rates, as proposed by DENC, and there are no conflicting positions with regard to these issues in this docket.
- 12. The Public Staff and DENC have reached agreement on all issues for purposes of this proceeding, and each agrees to waive cross-examination of the other party's witnesses. As such, the Public Staff and DENC request that their respective witnesses be excused from appearing at the hearing scheduled for November 22, 2021, unless the Commission has questions for them.
- 13. In addition, due to the continued number of coronavirus cases, DENC and the Public Staff believe it is safer for the evidentiary hearing scheduled for Tuesday, November 22, 2021, to be conducted remotely via Webex.
- 14. Counsel for CIGFUR I and CUCA have also agreed to waive crossexamination of the Public Staff's and DENC's witnesses and consented to the evidentiary hearing being conducted remotely.
- 15. In light of the foregoing, the Public Staff and DENC respectfully request that the Commission issue an order rescheduling the evidentiary hearing in this matter for the same date but to be conducted by remote means and excusing

the Public Staff's and DENC's witnesses from appearing at the evidentiary hearing scheduled in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, the Public Staff and DENC respectfully move:

- 1. That the Commission excuse George E. Hitch, Justin A. Wooldridge, Emilia L. Catron, Jay B. Lucas, and Charles A. Akpom from appearing at the hearing on November 22, 2021, unless the Commission has questions for any of these witnesses;
- 2. That the Commission accept the pre-filed testimony and exhibits and affidavits of these witnesses into the record;
- 3. That the Commission reschedule the November 22, 2021 evidentiary hearing in this matter to be held on the same date by remote means; and
- 4. That the Commission grant further relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
