On October 31, 2017, the Public Staff filed in the above-referenced docket its combined comments on the utilities' REPS Compliance Reports. Upon further review, one statement regarding the provision of REPS compliance services by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP) to the Town of Waynesville was included that is no longer accurate. In addition, in our discussion of the competitive procurement process established in S.L. 2017-192 (HB 589), the comments incorrectly stated that HB 589 called for the procurement of 2,660 MW of additional *solar* capacity, as opposed to renewable energy capacity. Attached are redlined and clean versions of the Public Staff's revised comments.

The Public Staff apologizes for this error and for any inconvenience it may have caused the Commission or the parties.
