BY THE CHAIR: On June 12, 2019, the Commission issued an order in the abovecaptioned docket requiring Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC), Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC, collectively electric utilities), and the Public Staff to file proposed orders on the electric utilities' integrated resource plans (IRPs) by July 12, 2019, and requesting that other parties wishing to file proposed orders do so by the same date.

On July 5, 2019, DENC filed reply comments to the comments of the Public Staff on DENC's revised IRP.

On July 10, 2019, the Public Staff and DENC (Movants), filed a joint motion requesting an extension of time to July 26, 2019. In summary, Movants stated that their attorneys and technical staff working on the IRP proposed orders are largely the same personnel that are preparing for and will be participating in the avoided cost hearing in Docket No. E-100, Sub 158, which is set to begin Monday, July 15, 2019, and will likely last for several days. Further, Movants stated that they need additional time to adequately incorporate DENC's recent reply comments, address the issues raised by the IRPs, and address the comments of intervenors. Finally, Movants stated that they have notified counsel for DEP and DEC of their intent to request an extension, and counsel did not object to the extension.

Based on Movants' motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the date for all parties to file proposed orders on the IRPs to July 26, 2019.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
