In his testimony filed August 26, 2020, Public Staff witness David M. Williamson indicated that the Public Staff had not concluded its review of the Save Energy and Water Kit (SEWK) Program (Evans Exhibit C). The Public Staff has concluded its review and it appears that there is an error in the calculation of the impacts, however, the Company states that it will not be able to incorporate this correction before the conclusion of this proceeding. As a result, Duke Energy Progress, LLC, and the Public Staff have agreed that the impacts should be corrected through the Experience Modification Factor in next year's Demand-side Management / Energy Efficiency Rider proceeding. Thus, the Public Staff requests that the review of Evans Exhibit C be held open until the next proceeding.
