Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina ("CWSNC" or "Company") submits for electronic filing in this docket its response to Commissioner Clodfelter's request for a Late-Filed Exhibit addressing certain questions concerning CWSNC's \$6,419,500 in anticipated post-test year additions.

The attached Excel document, verified by Anthony Gray, which updates Filing Form W1-10, Schedule A-15, for actual activity:

- 1. lists the estimated post-test year additions at the time of filing;
- 2. specifies those that are WSIC/SSIC eligible, and in what amount;
- 3. specifies those that are included in the Company's 3-year WSIC/SSIC plan; and
- 4. identifies the projects that were placed in-service in time for inclusion in this case, and their respective net rate base amounts.

The Company notes that the number of actual projects placed in-service was less than proposed, and that not all projects would be WSIC/SSIC eligible. The projects placed in-service which would be WSIC/SSIC eligible constitute approximately 6.79% of CWSNC's overall revenue request in the rate case.
