) ORDER GRANTING FURTHER ) EXTENSION OF TIME

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On April 19, 2021, in response to a motion by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively the Companies), the Commission issued an order extending the date for parties to file reply comments on the integrated resource plans (IRPs) of the Companies and Virginia Electric and Power Company d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina, to May 14, 2021.

On May 7, 2021, the Companies filed a motion requesting that the date for reply comments be further extended to May 28, 2021. In summary, the Companies cited the high volume of initial comments, exhibits and discovery requests concerning the IRPs, and the involvement of their personnel in an IRP hearing recently held before the Public Service Commission of South Carolina. Finally, the Companies stated that they contacted counsel for all parties of record about their motion via electronic mail, and that no counsel for any party who has responded has indicated any objection to the Companies' motion.

Based on the record and the Companies' motion, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend the date for parties to file reply comments to May 28, 2021.
