Duke Energy Progress, LLC, ("DEP") and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") (collectively "Duke Energy" or "Companies"), pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 62-155(f), the North Carolina Utilities Commission's ("NCUC" and the "Commission") April 3, 2018 Order Modifying And Approving Riders Implementing Solar Rebate Program, and the Commission's September 20, 2018 Order Modifying First Year of Solar Rebate Program hereby notify the Commission that the 2019 annual participation caps for residential customers & DEC non-residential customers under the Duke Energy's Solar Rebate Program have been met. Due to the customer interest in Duke Energy's Solar Rebate Program, the 2019 annual participation levels for certain groups of customers were reached quickly after the Companies launched the 2019 application window on January 2, 2019. The participation limit for 2019 has not been reached for the DEP non-residential customer class and non-profit customers.

NOTIFICATION OF ANNUAL PARTICIPATION LIMITS BEING REACHED

As directed by the Commission in its September 20, 2018 Order, Duke Energy hereby notifies the Commission that the annual participation limits for residential customers for both DEC and DEP as well as for DEC non-residential customers have

been reached, and the Companies' websites have been updated accordingly. A snapshot of the website informing the Public of the rebate limits being reached is shown as Appendix A.

Applications for residential and DEC non-residential customers will continue to be placed on a waitlist in the event previously accepted applications are rejected. The Companies are continuing to accept applications for DEP non-residential and non-profit customers, and the Companies will, in accordance with the Commission's September 20, 2018 Order, notify the Commission and update its website when the annual participation limit for DEP non-residential and non-profit customers is reached.

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Important Notice

Residential and DEC Non-residential Customer applications for solar rebates have reached the 2019 program capacity limit. All additional Residential and DEC Non-residential Customer applicants will be placed on the rebates waiting list.

2018 Reallocation

- Beginning in early January 2019, we will begin reallocating any 2018 reserved capacity that has not
 yet been installed. The reallocation is pursuant to an order established by the North Carolinas Utilities
 Commission. For customers, it means we will be reallocating capacity for the 2018 program.
- · Customers considered for reallocated capacity are those on the waiting list with:
 - Projects connected between Jan 1 July 26, 2018.
 - Projects connected between July 27 Dec 31, 2018.
