ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS

BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On February 16, 2021, the Commission issued an Order Granting Further Extension of Time, which in part required Sweetleaf Solar, LLC (Applicant) to file additional supplemental testimony regarding its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to construct a 94-MW solar photovoltaic (PV) electric generating facility located to be located in Halifax County, North Carolina.

On May 27, 2021, the Applicant filed a motion requesting that the Commission stay all proceedings in this docket. In support of its motion, the Applicant stated that it has been informed that PJM Interconnection (PJM) will provide revised interconnection studies for the Facility in the Fall of 2021. The Applicant further stated that the revised PJM interconnection studies will require Duke Energy Progress, LLC to revise its Affected System Study Report for the Facility. The Applicant requests that the Commission stay the proceedings in this docket, direct the Applicant to file in the docket any additional interconnection studies received for the Facility, and direct the Applicant to propose an appropriate procedural schedule after receipt of the additional interconnection studies.

Based on motion of the Applicant and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to grant the request to the stay the proceedings in this docket. The Applicant shall file any additional interconnection studies it receives for the Facility and may propose an appropriate procedural schedule after receipt of the additional interconnection studies.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
