COMMISSIONER BROWN-BLAND: Good evening. Let 2 us come to order and go on the record. I am Commissioner 3 ToNola D. Brown-Bland, presiding commissioner for this 4 5 hearing. With me this evening are Chairman Edward S. Finley, Jr., and Commissioners Bryan E. Beatty, Don M. 6 Bailey, Jerry C. Dockham, James G. Patterson and Lyons 7 8 Gray. I now call for hearing Docket Number G-5, Sub 9 565, In the Matter of an Application of Public Service 10 Company of North Carolina, Inc., for a General Increase 11 in its Rates and Charges. 12 On February 17th, 2016, Public Service Company 13 of North Carolina, hereafter Company or PSNC, gave notice 14 of its intent to file an Application for a General Rate 15 16 Increase. On March 3rd, 2016, Carolina Utility Customers 17 Association, Inc., CUCA, filed a Petition to Intervene 18 and an order granting the petition was issued by the 19 Commission on March 7th, 2016. 20 On March 31st, 2016, PSNC filed an Application, 21 direct testimony and exhibits requesting authority to 22 increase its rates and charges and to make various 23 changes to its terms and conditions of service. 24

1	On April 26th, 2016, the Commission issued an
2	Order Scheduling Investigation, Hearing, Suspending
3	Proposed Rates, Establishing Intervention and Testimony
4	Due Dates and Discovery Guidelines and requiring public
5	notice. Pursuant to the order, this general rate case is
6	scheduled for public hearing starting tonight, August
7	23rd, 2016 I mean 2016 in Gastonia; August 24th,
8	2016, in Asheville; August 25th in Statesville, and in
9	Raleigh on August 29th for the purpose of taking public
10	witness testimony on the application. The Commission's
11	order also scheduled an evidentiary hearing on the
12	application for Tuesday, August 30th, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.
13	in the Commission Hearing Room in Raleigh. At that time
14	the Commission will receive any additional public witness
15	testimony, followed by the expert witness testimony of
16	the parties.
17	On May 31st, 2016, Evergreen Packaging filed a
18	Petition to Intervene which was granted by the Commission
19	on June 2nd, 2016.
20	On June 13th, 2016, the Attorney General filed
21	a Notice of Intervention recognized pursuant to G.S. 62-
22	20.
23	The intervention and participation of the
24	Public Staff of the North Carolina Utilities Commission

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is recognized pursuant to General Statute 62-15(d) and 1 Commission Rule R1-19(e). 2 On June 16th, 2016, PSNC filed Affidavits of 3 Publication of Public Notice, and on June 23rd PSNC filed 4 5 certification that it had provided notice of hearing to each of its customers. 6 On August 18, 2016, PSNC, CUCA, Evergreen 7 Packaging and the Public Staff filed a Partial 8 Stipulation, and also on that date the Public Staff filed 9 its direct testimony. 10 Pursuant to G.S. 138A-15(e), I remind the 11 members of the Commission of our duty to avoid conflicts 12 of interest and inquire at this time as to whether any 13 commissioner has any known conflict of interest with 14 respect to this docket? 15 (No response.) 16 Let the record reflect that no conflicts were 17 18 identified. I now call upon counsel for the parties to 19 announce their appearance for the record, beginning with 20 the Applicant. 21 MS. GRIGG: Good evening, Commissioner Brown-22 Bland, members of the Commission. I am Mary Lynne Grigg 23 with the law firm of McGuireWoods, appearing on behalf of 24
