The Commission has scheduled the Application for public witness hearings on Thursday, October 7, 2021. These hearings shall be held remotely via Webex. The first session will begin at 1:30 p.m. and end at the earlier of the conclusion of the last witness' testimony or 4:30 p.m. The second session will begin at 6:30 p.m. and end at the earlier of the last witness' testimony or 10:30 p.m. A link to view the hearing will be available at [www.ncuc.net](http://www.ncuc.net). Members of the public that would like to testify must register in advance of the hearing, no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 1, 2021, by contacting the Public Staff via email at [ONSWCPublicHearing@psncuc.nc.gov](mailto:ONSWCPublicHearing@psncuc.nc.gov) or by calling 919-733-6110. Individuals registering to testify must provide their name, the docket number (W-1300, Sub 60), the time of the hearing at which they plan to speak, the telephone number they will use to participate in the hearing, and the topic of their testimony.

**Only individuals registered with the Public Staff by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 1, 2021, will be allowed to testify at the hearings.**

That the public witness hearings will be solely for the purpose of receiving the testimony of public witnesses in accordance with Commission Rule R1-21(g). The Commission reserves the right to limit testimony at the public witness hearings.

That the hearing will resume on Thursday, December 2, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., and will continue as required for testimony and cross-examination of expert witnesses for the Company, the Public Staff, and other intervenors. The Commission will issue a subsequent order scheduling the expert witness hearing to be held in person in Commission Hearing Room 2115 in Raleigh or remote via Webex and setting forth the procedures for the remote expert witness hearing.

The Public Staff is authorized by statute to represent consumers in proceedings before the Commission. Written statements to the Public Staff should include the name of the subdivision where the customer is receiving service, contact information, and any information that the writer wishes to be considered by the Public Staff in its investigation of the matter; these statements should be addressed to Mr. Christopher J. 
Written statements are not evidence unless those persons appear at a public hearing and testify concerning the information contained in their written statements.
