BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On September 9, 2019, the Commission held a hearing in the above-captioned docket. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Presiding Commissioner granted the Public Staff's request that the evidentiary record be held open until the Public Staff completed its review of data request responses submitted by Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), to the Public Staff. In addition, the Presiding Commissioner directed that briefs and proposed orders are due to be filed within thirty (30) days of the availability of the transcript.

On September 27, 2019, the transcript was filed in the docket.

On October 7, 2019, the Public Staff filed a letter stating that it has completed its review of DEP's data request responses, and that it found no material differences between the program costs as filed by DEP and the program costs reflected in the supporting documentation examined by the Public Staff. In addition, the Public Staff stated that its recommended demand-side management and energy efficiency program billing factors remain as set forth in the Supplemental Testimony and Exhibits filed on September 5, 2019, by DEP witnesses Carolyn T. Miller and Robert P. Evans.


